ASHE'S FERRY

A ferry nearby crossed the Catawba River between Lancaster County and York County for more than 30 years and was the last state-run ferry in S.C. It was built in 1927-28 by William N. Ashe (1862-1932), owner of the nearby Ashe Brick Company, to transport bricks and crops. As a private ferry it charged 25 cents for buggies and 35 cents for cars but was free after it became a public ferry.
